WHEREAS, the WTCPUA's fiscal year ends September 30 of each calendar year;

WHEREAS, the WTCPUA has been in the process of evaluating its wholesale water and wastewater rates for each of its wholesale water and wastewater customers;

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2015, the WTCPUA held a meeting of its wholesale customers at its offices to discuss potential amendments to its wholesale water and wastewater rates;

WHEREAS, on December 17, 2015, the WTCPUA Board of Directors, at a public meeting open to the public, considered whether to amend its wholesale water and wastewater rates for each of its wholesale water and wastewater customers;

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the WTCPUA desires to amend its wholesale water and wastewater rates for each of its wholesale customers, to be effective February 1, 2016.

NOW THEREFORE, it is ordered by the Board of Directors of West Travis County Public Utility Agency that:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Order for all purposes.

Section 2: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Dripping Springs Water Supply Corporation shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$13,692.30 and a volumetric rate of \$1.74 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 3: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Senna Hills Municipal Utility District No. 1 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$8,383.84 and a volumetric rate of \$1.68 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 4: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Crystal Mountain Homeowners Association, Inc.

shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$2,353.51 and a volumetric rate of \$2.38 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 5: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Barton Creek West Water Supply Corporation shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$9,815.40 and a volumetric rate of \$2.34 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 6: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Eanes Independent School District shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$766.86 and a volumetric rate of \$2.46 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 7: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Travis County Municipal Utility District No. 18 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$4,157.84 and a volumetric rate of \$2.01 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 8: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Hays County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$17,564.06 and a volumetric rate of \$1.69 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 9: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Hays County Water Control and Improvement District No. 2 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$13,309.00 and a volumetric rate of \$1.84 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 10: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Lazy Nine Municipal Utility District No. 1A shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$10,808.74 and a volumetric rate of \$1.79 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 11: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Deer Creek Ranch Water Company shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$8,010.74 and a volumetric rate of \$1.81 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 12: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Reunion Ranch Water Control and Improvement District shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$3,939.63 and a volumetric rate of \$1.95 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 13: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale water rate for the Travis County Municipal Utility District No. 12 shall

include a monthly minimum charge of \$25,787.02 and a volumetric rate of \$1.68 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.


Section 14: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale wastewater rate for the Travis County Water Control and Improvement District No. 17 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$15,152.14 and a volumetric rate of \$4.51 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 15: The Board of Directors of the WTCPUA hereby approves, adopts, and orders that the wholesale wastewater rate for the Travis County Municipal Utility District No. 18 shall include a monthly minimum charge of \$9,910.20 and a volumetric rate of \$4.91 per 1,000 gallons, effective February 1, 2016.

Section 16: The Agency's General Manager, Engineer, and General Counsel are authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the purposes of this Order, including, but not limited to, providing notice of the proposed increases to WTCPUA customers and amending the Tariff.


